

## **Recreate Famous Paintings**

The J. Paul Getty Museum in Los Angeles is challenging people to recreate famous paintings at home during the COVID-19 pandemic. I would like you to try the same! Start by searching for famous artwork online, and pick a few that interest you. (If you click on this link, you can tour 500 famous museums from around the world: <a href="https://artsandculture.google.com/partner">https://artsandculture.google.com/partner</a>)

You will **set a timer** in your kitchen, or on your phone, for 30 minutes. Some photos may take longer than others (the piano one would probably take a lot longer than the girl with the toilet paper). So, however many photos you create in 2.5 hours this week (a half hour each school day), will be accepted. For example, if one photo takes an hour, and 3 others take a half hour, you only need to complete 4 total. You should definitely be completing more than one!

Next, you will **find objects from around your house** and take a photo, to re-create the famous painting in a creative way! You can use people or pets that live with you in your work. You can also use face paint or make up (like in the middle left photo), with parent permission. See the examples below for an idea of what Ms. T. is looking for. (**You are NOT painting or coloring for this project.)** Ms. T. also recently posted student examples on the class website between weeks 11 and 12- check them out!

You will email or Remind101 them all to Ms. Taube in one message on Friday. Please include the famous painting too, so that Ms. T. can look at your photo and the original, side by side. Good luck and have fun! ©
