

## “Found Object Color Wheel” Challenge

Start by setting a kitchen timer, or the timer on your phone for 30 minutes. You will work on this project for 30 minutes each school day this week (or **2.5 hours total**).

You will collect objects from around your house that match *all* 12 colors that you see on the color wheel to the right. Find objects that are also in-between these colors (for example: you might find an object that is between blue and blue-green). You must have *more* than 12 objects in your project (remember- it should look like you are spending 2.5 hours on this in order to receive credit.)

You will then create your own “color wheel” with these objects, and take a photo of it. The colors *must* be in order! Get creative! You can have a theme to the objects that you find. For example, they could all be objects related to art, the outdoors, sports, beauty, or food. You can put a drawing or a quote in the middle, or behind the objects. You can create a piece of art (like the top left photo, where they glued down beads). Your pet can be in the photo (like the top middle photo).

See the examples below, to get an idea of what Ms. T. is looking for, or Google “found object color wheel challenge” for more ideas. Ms. T. also posted student examples between weeks 11 and 12 on the class website. Have fun (and please make sure to clean up after yourself when you’re finished)!
